## Guidelines on Application for Advanced Standing

### Students Eligible for Applying for Advanced Standing

- UG students transfer from other universities
- Associate Degree (AD) and Higher Diploma (HD) holders (admitted to Year 1 or Year 3)
- 7-year secondary schooling with IB Diploma or GCE A-Level qualifications
- 7-year secondary schooling with other examination qualifications

In accordance with EN13 of the Regulations for the Degree of Bachelor of Engineering in Biomedical Engineering advanced standing may be granted to candidates in recognition of studies completed successfully before admission to the University in accordance with UG2 of the Regulations for First Degree Curricula. The amount of advanced credits to be granted shall be determined by the Board of the School, in accordance with the following principles:

- (a) a minimum of four semesters of study at this University shall be required before a candidate is considered for the award of the degree; and
- (b) at least half of the credits requirements of the degree curriculum shall be accumulated through study at this University, or from transfer of credits for courses completed at other institutions in accordance with UG4(d) of the Regulations for First Degree Curricula.

Credits granted for advanced standing shall not normally be included in the calculation of the GPA unless permitted by the Board of the School but will be recorded on the transcript of the candidate after they are successfully transfer to a specify programme in their second year studies.

### Policy on Granting Advanced Standing

#### Notes:

1. Students are required to complete 6 courses (36 credits) in the Common Core Curriculum in different five Areas of Inquiry (AoI). Students shall select at least one but no more than two courses from each AoI during their studies.
